YACHT CODE SUPPLEMENT No. 02-18

To: Yacht Owners/Captains, Managers, Agents, Recognized Classification Societies, and Appointed Representatives

Subject: SUPPLEMENT TO YACHT CODE AMENDING CHAPTER II, SECTION 3.1; CHAPTER III, SECTION 3.1; AND CHAPTER IV, SECTION 3.1

Publication Date: 15 June 2018

In accordance with Chapter I, Section 2.12 of the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) Yacht Code (the “Code”), this supplement amends Chapter II, Section 3.1, Chapter III Section 3.1, and IV, Section 3.1 of the Code as follows:

Chapter II, Section 3.1;

In accordance with RMI law and regulations, all commercial yachts regardless of size and registration date, must be annually inspected by an AR, as applicable, to verify compliance with this Code. This Compliance Verification is in addition to, and separate from, any other inspections or surveys that may be required to meet Class or international statutory requirements.

See *Conducting Surveys and Issuance of International Convention and National Certificates for Commercial Yachts, Passenger Yachts and Yachts Engaged in Trade* ([MN 2-011-53](#)) for further guidance on compliance verification requirements.

Chapter III, Section 3.1;

In accordance with RMI laws and regulations, all PAXYs regardless of size and registration date, must be annually inspected by an AR, as applicable, to verify compliance with this Code. This Compliance Verification is in addition to, and separate from, any other inspections or surveys that may be required to meet Class or international statutory requirements.

Chapter IV, Section 3.1;

In accordance with RMI law and regulations, all PYLCs regardless of size and registration date, must be annually inspected by an AR, as applicable, to verify compliance with the Code. This Compliance Verification is in addition to, and separate from, any other inspections or surveys that may be required to meet Class or international statutory requirements.

This supplement shall be deemed to be incorporated into the Code and shall take full force and effect as of the Publication Date listed above.
