

PRIVATE YACHT


Guest numbers exceeding overnight berths, life-saving appliances, or sewage capacity.



Where guest numbers are below the number of berths, life-saving appliances, or sewage capacity, there are no requirements for a risk assessment to be conducted.

COMMERCIAL YACHT / PAXY / YET / PYLC

Passenger numbers above those stated on the RMI Yacht Code Compliance Certificate.



¹ The Risk Assessment is not required to be submitted to the Republic of the Marshall Islands Maritime Administrator. Should interested third-parties (e.g., insurance, costal State, port authorities) require flag consent, a No Objection Letter can be requested as per the RMI Yacht Code, Chapter II, Section 27.1.2.
