Subject: CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR VESSELS ARRIVING AT UNITED STATES PORTS FROM CERTAIN COUNTRIES

Date: 27 April 2021

This Yacht Safety Advisory (YSA) supersedes YSA No. 10-19.

The United States Coast Guard (USCG) has determined that the Republic of Liberia is now maintaining effective anti-terrorism measures in its ports. The Republic of Liberia has been removed from the list of affected countries in paragraph B of USCG [Port Security Advisory No. 2-20](#). Therefore, effective immediately, actions required in paragraphs C and D of this Port Security Advisory are no longer required for vessels that arrive in the United States (US) after visiting ports in the Republic of Liberia.

Please be reminded that all ships submitting Advance Notice of Arrival with the US are also required to copy the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) Maritime Administrator (the "Administrator") via email at NOA@register-iri.com.
