Subject: CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR VESSELS ARRIVING AT UNITED STATES PORTS FROM CERTAIN COUNTRIES

Date: 19 August 2022

This Yacht Safety Advisory (YSA) supersedes YSA No. 03-21.

The United States Coast Guard (USCG) has determined that the Republic of Cote d'Ivoire is now maintaining effective anti-terrorism measures in its ports. The Republic of Cote d'Ivoire was removed from the Countries Affected list in paragraph B of [Port Security Advisory 1-22](#). Therefore, effective immediately, actions required in paragraphs C and D of this Port Security Advisory are no longer required for vessels that arrive in the United States (US) after visiting ports in the Republic of Côte d'Ivoire.

Please be reminded that all ships submitting Advance Notice of Arrival with the US are also required to copy the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) Maritime Administrator (the "Administrator") via email at NOA@register-iri.com.
