**Private Yacht Voluntary Compliance Levels** 

#### 1.0 Introduction

This Yacht Technical Circular provides the levels of compliance that owners of private registered yachts may choose, when maintaining a Yacht Statement of Voluntary Compliance (SoVC).

#### 2.0 General

## 2.1 Voluntary Compliance

- .1 The Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) Maritime Administrator (the "Administrator") allows owners to certify and operate their private yachts on a voluntary basis to a higher standard than required by the RMI Maritime Regulations and Yacht Code 2021 ("Yacht Code"), or international conventions.
- .2 The SoVC is not a compliance certificate. Its sole purpose is to confirm that the yacht voluntarily complies fully or partially with more stringent requirements. It does not authorize a private yacht to engage in any commercial yacht activity and the requirements applicable to private yachts under the RMI Maritime Act 1990 and the Maritime Regulations continue to govern.

#### 2.2 Voluntary Compliance Levels

- .1 The Administrator acknowledges that some owners may not wish to voluntarily comply with all requirements of the higher standards. To accommodate this, the owner is given the choice of different compliance levels (Levels 1 thru Level 5, based on tonnage) as provided in the Appendix.
- .2 To initiate the voluntary compliance process, owners or their designated representatives must email the Administrator and request an SoVC at: <a href="mailto:yachttec@register-iri.com">yachttec@register-iri.com</a>. The request must specify the desired compliance level against which the yacht is to be inspected. In addition, form <a href="mailto:MI-127PY">MI-127PY</a>, <a href="mailto:Declaration of Use-Not for Hire">Declaration of Use-Not for Hire</a>, must be filled out and submitted.
